

NOTIFICATION OF THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR

On the due date extension for filing and payment of contributions via electronic systems (e-Payment)**B.E. 2565 (2022)**

Whereas it is expedient to extend the due date for employer's filing and payment of contributions via electronic systems (e-Payment) to promote and facilitate the employer's ease of doing business and the insured person's protection, as well as to mitigate and remedy the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic and to encourage the social distancing measures by supporting employers in making transactions via electronic systems.

By virtue of section 84/2 of the Social Security Act, B.E. 2533 (1990) as amended by the Order of the Head of the National Council for Peace and Order No. 21/2560 on the law amendment to facilitate the Doing Business, dated 4 April 2017, the Minister of Labour, with the approval of the Cabinet, hereby issues the following announcement:

Clause 1. Extend the due date of contribution filing and payment, for the employer who files and pays the contribution in compliance with section 47 of the Social Security Act B.E. 2533 (1990) amended by the Social Security Act (the fourth edition) B.E. 2558 (2015) via electronic systems (e – Payment), for another seven working days starting from the day after the fifteenth day of the month following the month of deduction.

The execution of the first paragraph shall be applied to the contribution filing and payment of salaries starting from the month in which this notification come into force for a period of twenty-four months.

Clause 2, This notification shall come into force from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
